



Right to Buy: Financial Information

This form should be used by tenants who wish to claim the right to purchase their home under the Right to Buy scheme.

You could be eligible for a Right to Buy discount if:

- ✓ You are a secure tenant of Tendring District Council
- ✓ The property is your only or principal home
- ✓ You have been a public sector tenant (usually a tenant of a council or a housing association) for at least three years
- ✓ You don't live in sheltered housing or other housing particularly suitable for elderly or disabled people or your tenancy of an elderly persons dwelling commenced when you were under the age of 60
- ✓ Your home is not due to be demolished
- ✓ You don't have any legal problems with debt
- ✓ You don't have any outstanding possession orders

If you can answer 'yes' to these statements, you are probably eligible for the Right to Buy but Tendring District Council will need to confirm this.

This form is used to consider your eligibility for a Right to Buy. It is used in conjunction with the RTB1 Application Form.

When you have filled in both of these forms, take them or send them (by recorded delivery if you wish) to Tendring District Council.
