RE: REQUEST FOR THE RELEASE OF SECTION 106 CONTRIBUTIONS TO ST OSYTH PARISH COUNCIL

The Council has recently received from St Osyth Parish Council a request for Section 106 monies towards the cost of replacing existing unusable lighting at Cowley Park and to provide illumination, and therefore increased use, to the skate park adjacent to the pavilion in the Park.

Whilst this project is not identified in the Councils assessment of play need as a high priority, a copy of which is in your possession, the lighting improvements will make the existing facilities on the site more accessible to existing users and encourage the sites use by new users.

Attached is a copy of the signed release form from Planning Services.

In accordance with the Council's scheme of delegated powers I propose to allocate £1,550 from Section 106 contributions towards a total budget of £3,876.00 that St Osyth Parish Council propose to spend on lighting at Cowley Park, St Osyth.
