Decision Made:	To accept the transfer of part only of the freehold of the open space land identified in the S106 agreement dated 12 March 2010 forming the Albert Edward Hall, within the Open Space & Bereavement Services Manager's decision to adopt all of the land and Cabinet's decision on 04 September 2015 to lease it to the Community Centre charity.
