Elmstead Market



A walk from Elmstead Market to Great Bromley

Walk along Bromley Road until you come to the entrance of Lodge Farm on your left. Following this track continue through Lodge Farm, passing a pond on your right and fields either side of you. Ahead on your right is community woodland. When the track reaches the A120 it splits two ways; take the left hand track for about 100m where you will se a stile on your left. Go over the stile and turn left where the A120 is below and alongside you. This path eventually comes out at a bridge which takes you over the busy main road.

Once over the bridge, continue along a wide grassy track bordered with broom and gorse until you reach steps on your left hand side. Take these steps down, across the stile a few metres to your right and cross the field to more steps and a footbridge over Bromley Brook. Once over the brook you are briefly in Boudge Hill wood which rises, bringing you out to the edge of a field where you cross reaching a farm track which takes you into Great Bromley almost opposite the charming 15th Century Church (the church will have been a prominent feature on the horizon for most of the walk).
