Out of Season Promenade Gate Access Permit

To obtain the Out of Season Permit for promenade gate access you must complete our online form, where your details will be reviewed by an Officer. Once the relevant checks have been authorised, a member of the Beach Huts Team will provide you with a permit.

We require 14 days notice. A response will be given to all applications received. For any questions, the Beach Huts Team can be contacted by phone Monday – Friday, 9am – 3pm.

To obtain a Permit you will need to agree to the following Terms and Conditions:-

Permission must be granted from the Council via prior arrangement to access the promenade gates outside of the usual existing restricted hours in place and the details of the vehicle will be logged – Registration Number and Make/ Model of vehicle, along with the beach hut number and location.

Request for gate codes to be obtained in the usual way, by either completing the relevant Gate Access online form or by calling the Beach Huts team on (01255) 686702, Monday – Friday, 9am – 3pm.

The gate code is not to be distributed to others.

When accessing the promenade by vehicle, hazard lights must be visible at all times.

When the vehicle is moving, please do not exceed the maximum speed limit of 5mph.

The permit must be displayed in the vehicles windscreen and clearly visible when the vehicle is stationery,

No blocking the access to the promenade gate(s)

Do not park or drive over the Greenswards or Green Spaces.

Do not remove / alter the gate(s), posts or padlock(s) under any circumstances.

It is your responsibility to make sure the access gate is closed and relocked immediately each and every time you use it to prevent any unauthorised access.

Access with the permit is only permitted within the dates displayed on the permit. A new request will need to be made for any additional dates not previously requested.

The person carrying out any maintenance must present a copy of their Public Liability Insurance and a Risk Assessment before a Permit will be issued.

Any breach to the Terms & Conditions may put the beach hut licence/ leases at risk.
