

APPLICATION FOR A BOATMAN'S LICENCE GUIDANCE NOTES

Tendring District Council only issue Boatman Licences for those who operate within the following areas:

Brightlingsea, Harwich, Walton on the Naze, and St Osyth.

To qualify for a Boatman's Licence, an applicant must:

- Be over 18 years of age.
- Not suffer from any disease or physical disability which could affect their fitness to assist in the charge of pleasure boats.
- Be able to complete a declaration as to their fitness, matters to be considered are any limb defects which restrict mobility or movement, epilepsy, fainting, or cardiovascular problems or mental illness.
- Hold a minimum of a RYA Level 2 Powerboat Certificate.
- Submit a recent passport sized colour photograph with your name on the reverse. Your image will be shown on the ID card/licence issued to you.

Information

- Crew venturing outside the areas listed above will need to obtain a qualification that is recognised by the Maritime and Coastguard Agency (MCA) under their relevant code of practice.
- The appropriate fee should accompany this application. This fee applies to all licences due on or after 31st March. Payment can be made by either cheque or credit/debit card. Payments made by card may be done by telephoning 01255 686565. Payments made by cheque should be made payable to Tendring District Council.
- Boatman Licences expire on 31st March annually.
