

# NOTICE OF ELECTION

## ELECTION OF PARISH COUNCILLOR FOR FRINTON & WALTON TOWN COUNCIL (FRINTON WARD)

1. Those wishing to be candidates at this election must submit a valid nomination paper within the period for delivery of completed nomination papers.
2. Nomination papers may be obtained from the offices of the Returning Officer at the address shown in point 10 below, during office opening hours (9.00 a.m. to 3.00 p.m. Monday to Friday), who will, at the request of any local government elector for the said ward, prepare a nomination paper for signature.
3. Completed nomination papers must be delivered by hand to the Returning Officer at the address shown in point 10 below, during office opening hours (9.00 a.m. to 3.00 p.m. Monday to Friday and between 9.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. on Thursday, 08 May 2025), from the date of this notice but not later than 4.00 p.m. on Thursday, 08 May 2025.
4. If the election is contested, the poll will take place on Thursday, 05 June 2025 between the hours of 7.00 a.m. and 10.00 p.m.
5. The last day to submit an application to be included in the electoral register to be used at this election is Monday, 19 May 2025. Applications can be made to the Electoral Registration Officer at the address shown in point 10 below or online at [www.gov.uk/register-to-vote](http://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote). For electors voting in polling stations there is a legal requirement to take a prescribed form of photographic identification to vote. A full list of the prescribed forms of photographic identification is available at [www.tendringdc.gov.uk/services/elections-and-voting](http://www.tendringdc.gov.uk/services/elections-and-voting). For those who require a Voter Authority Certificate to meet the requirement for photographic identification, applications can be made at [voter-authority-certificate.service.gov.uk](http://voter-authority-certificate.service.gov.uk).
6. Applications for, amendments to or cancellations of arrangements to vote by post or by proxy must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the address shown in point 10 below, by 5.00 p.m. on Tuesday, 20 May 2025 if they are to be effective for this election.
7. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the address shown in point 10 below, by 5.00 p.m. on Wednesday, 28 May 2025.
8. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election - applied for on grounds of a medical emergency (occurring after 5.00 p.m. on Wednesday, 28 May 2025), because of work/service reasons (occurring after 5.00 p.m. on Wednesday, 28 May 2025) or the form of acceptable photographic identification that you were intending to use to vote has been lost, stolen, damaged or destroyed, or has not yet been received if applied for recently - must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the address shown in point 10 below by 5.00 p.m. on Thursday, 05 June 2025.
