Decision Made:	To complete the disposal of the land (section of land at Grove Avenue, Walton-on-the-Naze, Essex) on the terms set out in the Cabinet Report (B1) subject to an uplifted price because the land is not being sold to a Registered Housing Provider. Such other terms and conditions considered appropriate by the Decision Maker include the sale being to two development companies jointly. All other terms and conditions being standard in their nature

It was considered appropriate to sell to the two development companies jointly because the title documents for the neighbouring development site, the development of which this land is being sold to facilitate, are in joint names
