Coast protection works to reinforce and improve a section of seawall below the Hazlemere Road Car Park, Holland on Sea have now been completed.

The improvements consisted of driving new steel sheet piles to provide a footing in front of the existing wall and constructing a new stepped seawall in front of the old wall supported by this footing. The length of seawall which has been improved is approximately 150 metres.

A new beach access ramp and a set of beach access steps have also been constructed and the promenade has been resurfaced.

The project was managed by Technical and Procurement Services on behalf of the Technical Services Portfolio Holder, and was funded by DEFRA through the Environment Agency.
