Field Scabious
(*Knautia arvensis*)

Some plants attract different species of butterflies and bees that will pollinate the flowers, this in turn provides a food source for birds and other animals.



Yarrow
(*Achillea millefolium*)



Oxeye Daisy
(*Leucanthemum vulgare*)



Buddleia
(*Buddleja davidii*)

Most wild flowers thrive in poor soil conditions, hence the flowers do well here even though the soil in the park is mostly clay and of low fertility.



Self Heal
(*Prunella vulgaris*)

Other wild flowers have self seeded and grown in this area and throughout the park. The seeds being imported by the wind, birds and animals.
