STILLWATERS AND RIVERS

Green Lane Farm Fishery, Weeley (off A133 Clacton bypass)

Holland Brook

Holland Brook is a small coastal river, slow flowing with roach as the dominant species in this mixed coarse fishery. Fishing restricted to weekdays only between 16 June - 14 March.

Weekly permits (no day tickets) are available and must be purchased in advance from Brian Dean Tackle, Pallister Road, Clacton on Sea. 01255 425992.

There is open access to part of the river at Holland on Sea.
