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01 COMPLIANCE REQUIRED: COMMENCEMENT TIME LIMIT

CONDITION: The development hereby permitted shall be begun not later the expiration of three years from the date of this permission.

REASON: To comply with the requirements of Section 91 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 as amended by Section 51 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004.

NOTE/S FOR CONDITION:

The development needs to commence within the timeframe provided. Failure to comply with this condition will result in the permission becoming lapsed and unable to be carried out. If commencement takes place after the time lapses this may result in unlawful works at risk Enforcement Action proceedings. You should only commence works when all other conditions requiring agreement prior to commencement have been complied with.

02 APPROVED PLANS & DOCUMENTS

CONDITION: The development hereby permitted shall be carried out in accordance with the drawings/documents listed below and/or such other drawings/documents as may be approved by the Local Planning Authority in writing pursuant to other conditions of this permission or such drawings/documents as may subsequently be approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority as a non-material amendment following an application in that regard (except for Listed Building Consents). Such development hereby permitted shall be carried out in accordance with any Phasing Plan approved, or as necessary in accordance with any successive Phasing Plan as may subsequently be approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority prior to the commencement of development pursuant to this condition.

REASON: For the avoidance of doubt and in the interests of proper phased planning of the development.

NOTE/S FOR CONDITION:

The primary role of this condition is to confirm the approved plans and documents that form the

planning decision. Any document or plan not listed in this condition is not approved, unless otherwise separately referenced in other conditions that also form this decision. The second role of this condition is to allow the potential process of Non Material Amendment if found necessary and such future applications shall be considered on their merits. Lastly, this condition also allows for a phasing plan to be submitted for consideration as a discharge of condition application should phasing be needed by the developer/s if not otherwise already approved as part of this permission. A phasing plan submission via this condition is optional and not a requirement.

Please note in the latest revision of the National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF) it provides that Local Planning Authorities should seek to ensure that the quality of approved development is not materially diminished between permission and completion, as a result of changes being made to the permitted scheme (for example through changes to approved details such as the materials used). Accordingly, any future amendment of any kind will be considered in line with this paragraph, alongside the Development Plan and all other material considerations.

Any indication found on the approved plans and documents to describe the plans as approximate and/or not to be scaled and/or measurements to be checked on site or similar, will not be considered applicable and the scale and measurements shown shall be the approved details and used as necessary for compliance purposes and/or enforcement action.

03 FURTHER APPROVAL: MITIGATION TO BE AGREED, RAMS

CONDITION: Prior to the commencement of any demolition works to facilitate the erection of the self-build dwelling, detailed proposals addressing the mitigation of the development's impact on protected Essex Habitats Sites shall be submitted to and received written approval from the Local Planning Authority. Such proposals must provide for mitigation in accordance with the joint Habitats Regulations Assessment Essex Coast Recreational Disturbance Avoidance and Mitigation Strategy (RAMS) or demonstrate mitigation measures of an equivalent effectiveness.

These proposals may require on site or off site mitigation, but in either case must include evidence of the completion of a necessary legal agreement to secure the proposed mitigation and/or contribution towards mitigation. Please note a legal agreement will include legal fees and may require obligations to secure monitoring and associated fees. For any on site mitigation proposals approved, it shall be carried out in full and thereafter shall be maintained as approved.

REASON: In order to safeguard protected wildlife species and their habitats in accordance with the NPPF and Habitats Regulations. Failure to achieve satisfactory mitigation would result in harm by new residents due to the development's impact on protected sites.

NOTE/S FOR CONDITION:

This condition establishes the necessity to ensure the implementation of appropriate mitigation measures due to the impact of the approved development. Such mitigation may be required on-site, off-site, or a combination of both.

Typically, a contribution towards visitor management measures at the protected Habitats Site(s) is the preferred and simplest approach to fulfil the requirements of this condition. To fulfil this requirement, you can contribute funds towards a range of mitigation projects in the protected areas. It is essential to secure this provision through a legal agreement between the Council, Developer/Applicant, and site owners before occupation. If this is the approach to fulfilling this condition you wish to take, you are strongly advised to finalise the legal agreement with the Council before submitting any request to discharge this condition. Failure to conclude the

LEGAL AGREEMENT REQUIRED TO DISCHARGE CONDITION

As per the relevant condition above, this application requires mitigation against recreational Impact in accordance with The Essex Coast Recreational disturbance Avoidance and Mitigation Strategy (RAMS) and Regulation 63 of the Conservation of Habitat and Species Regulations 2017. The current RAMS tariff is £163.86 per new dwelling (from the 1st April 2024). To satisfy a RAMS condition and allow a condition to be formally discharged, a completed UU must be submitted with a Discharge of Condition application.

Prior to the submission of the Discharge of Condition application, we can prepare the UU for you (to be reviewed by your solicitor) or we can review a draft UU you have provided (drafted by your solicitor). Both services will incur a charge.

04 ACTION REQUIRED: RESIDENTIAL TRAVEL PACK PRIOR TO OCCUPATION

CONDITION: Prior to first occupation of the dwelling hereby approved, a Residential Travel Information Pack (travel pack) shall be provided for use of its first occupiers. The travel pack shall be agreed, in writing, by the local planning authority prior to provision and shall include a minimum of six one day travel vouchers for use with a local transport operator.

REASON: In the interests of reducing the need to travel by car and promoting sustainable development and transport.

Note: Please contact the Travel Plan Team at ECC Highways via email to Travel.PlanTeam@essex.gov.uk to obtain a Residential Travel Information Pack template and the associated day travel vouchers required.

05 ACTION REQUIRED: REFUSE BINS AND COLLECTION AREAS

CONDITION: Prior to occupation of the dwelling hereby approved details for the storage of refuse/recycling bins shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority and then retained in perpetuity.

REASON: In the interest of highway safety to ensure that refuse recycling bins do not cause any obstruction or danger on the highway.

NOTE/S FOR CONDITION:

It is an OFFENCE to carry out works within the public highway, which includes a Public Right of Way, without the permission of the ECC Highway Authority. Any conditions which involve work within the limits of the public highway do not give the applicant permission to carry them out. Unless otherwise agreed in writing all works within the public highway shall be carried out by Essex County Council or its agents at the applicant's expense.

06 APPROVAL REQUIRED: LANDSCAPING SCHEME

CONDITION: No development above slab level shall take place until there has been submitted to and approved, in writing, by the Local Planning Authority a scheme of hard, soft and boundary treatment landscaping works for the site, which shall include any proposed changes in ground levels.

REASON: In the interests of visual amenity and the character and appearance of the area.

NOTE/S FOR CONDITION:

Slab level normally refers to the concrete slab supported on foundations or directly on the subsoil and is used to construct the ground floor of the development. In any other case, please assume slab level to be the point before any walls and/or development can be visually above ground level or seek confirmation from the Local Planning Authority for your development.

Should the landscape works include any new hedgerow, please consider the following planting for a native hedge. Native hedge: 50% hawthorn, 25% blackthorn (but beware - this can spread into adjacent fields), 15% field maple, 2% holly, 2% wild privet, 2% guelder rose, 2% dog rose, 2% buckthorn.

07 COMPLIANCE WITH DETAILS AND TIMESCALE REQUIRED - LANDSCAPING SCHEME

CONDITION: All changes in ground levels, soft/hard landscaping shown on the approved landscaping details shall be carried out in full during the first planting and seeding season (October - March inclusive) following the commencement of the development, or in such other phased arrangement as may be approved, in writing, by the Local Planning Authority up to the first use/first occupation of the development. Any trees, hedges, shrubs or turf identified within the approved landscaping details (both proposed planting and existing) which die, are removed, seriously damaged or seriously diseased, within a period of 10 years of being planted, or in the case of existing planting within a period of 5 years from the commencement of development, shall be replaced in the next planting season with others of similar size and same species unless otherwise agreed in writing by the Local Planning Authority.

REASON: To ensure that the approved landscaping scheme has sufficient time to establish, in the interests of visual amenity and the character and appearance of the area.

08 FURTHER APPROVAL: AGREEMENT OF MATERIALS

CONDITION: No development/works shall be commenced above slab level until precise details of the manufacturer and types and colours of the external facing and roofing materials to be used in construction have been submitted to and approved, in writing, by the Local Planning Authority. Such materials as may be agreed shall be those used in the development and fully applied prior to the first use/occupation.

REASON: To secure an orderly and well-designed finish sympathetic to the character of the existing building(s) and in the interests of visual amenity and the character and appearance of the area.

NOTE/S FOR CONDITION:

Slab level is normally refers to the concrete slab supported on foundations or directly on the subsoil and is used to construct the ground floor of the development. In any other case, please assume slab level to be the point before any walls and/or development can be visually above ground level or seek confirmation from the Local Planning Authority for your development.

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While this condition does not detail in what form the materials sought shall be detailed to the Local Planning Authority, it is suggested that a plan is submitted with the details to show where the materials will be located and the extent of coverage.

09 OBSCURE GLAZING & REMOVAL OF PD (INS)

CONDITION: Notwithstanding the provisions of Article 3, Schedule 2, Part 1 of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 2015 (or any Order revoking and re-enacting that Order with or without modification), the first floor en-suite window in the south elevation shall be glazed in obscured glass before the development hereby permitted is first occupied/used and shall thereafter be permanently retained in this approved form. The obscured glass shall be designed as equal or higher than Pilkington Textured Glass Level 5 Standard as published January 2010 (as amended).

REASON: To protect the privacy and amenities of the occupiers of neighbouring property.

NOTE FOR CONDITION

Level 5 is also referred to as Privacy Level 5 and this web site may be of use, the Council accepts no responsibility for content.

10 SPECIFIC RESTRICTION ON DEVELOPMENT: SELF-BUILD AND CUSTOM-BUILD

CONDITION: The dwelling approved by this permission shall be occupied only by persons who have built or commissioned the building of the dwelling/s for their own occupation and use as a self-build project in accordance with the Self-build and Custom Housebuilding Act 2015 for a minimum of 24 hours from first occupation by said persons.

Furthermore, the following scheduled actions shall be undertaken.

- o Prior to commencement of the development, details of the (a) individuals, (b) associations of individuals, or (c) persons working with or for individuals or associations of individuals, both building the development and who are to occupy the dwelling/s if different shall be confirmed in writing to the local planning authority. Should there be any changes to these details during construction, these shall be updated in writing to the local planning authority.
- o On first occupation details of the first occupier of the dwelling shall be confirmed in writing to the local planning authority and subsequently the Local Planning Authority shall be informed of if and when that occupier changes within the first year of occupation.

REASON: The dwelling approved by this permission shall be occupied only by persons who have built or commissioned the building of the dwelling/s for their own occupation and use as a self-build project in accordance with the Self-build and Custom Housebuilding Act 2015 (as amended) and to accord with provisions of the Local Plan and NPPF.

11 SUSTAINABLE ENERGY EFFICIENCY MEASURES

CONDITION: No development shall commence above slab level until a scheme for the provision and implementation of water, energy and resource efficiency measures for the lifetime of the development shall be submitted to and approved, in writing, by the Local Planning Authority. The scheme should include as a minimum the following:-

- Agreement of carbon level;

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- Agreement of provisions to ensure the development is zero carbon ready;
- Agreement of heating of each dwelling/building; and
- Agreement of scheme for waste reduction

The scheme shall be fully implemented prior to the first occupancy of the development unless otherwise agreed in writing by the Local Planning Authority. The scheme shall be constructed and the measures provided and made available for use as may be agreed and thereafter shall be maintained.

REASON: To enhance the sustainability of the development through better use of water, energy and resources reduce harm to the environment and result in wider public benefit in accordance with the NPPF.

NOTE/S FOR CONDITION:

Slab level is normally refers to the concrete slab supported on foundations or directly on the subsoil and is used to construct the ground floor of the development. In any other case, please assume slab level to be the point before any walls and/or development can be visually above ground level or seek confirmation from the Local Planning Authority for your development.

The risk assessment shall assess the nature and extent of any contamination on the site, whether or not it originates on the site. The investigation and risk assessment must be undertaken by competent persons and a written report of the findings must be produced. The report of the findings must include:

- (i) a survey of extent, scale and nature of contamination;
- (ii) an assessment of the potential risks to:
 - Human health,
 - Properly (existing or proposed) including buildings, crops, livestock, pets, woodland and service lines and pipes,
 - Adjoining land,
 - Groundwaters and surface waters,
 - Ecological systems
 - Archaeological sites and ancient monuments;
- (iii) an appraisal of remedial options, and proposal of the preferred option(s).

REASON - To ensure that any risks (to future users of the land and neighbouring land and to controlled waters, property and ecological systems) arising from any land contamination are minimised and to ensure that the development can be carried out safely without unacceptable risks to workers, neighbours and other offsite receptors.

REASON: For the avoidance of doubt and in the interests of proper phased planning of the development.

03 COMPLIANCE: IN ACCORDANCE WITH AMS

CONDITION: The development hereby approved shall be carried out in strict accordance with the Arboricultural Method Statement (AMS) (Arbtech Consulting Limited, May 2024) and accompanying appendices. The tree protection measures detailed on drawing number Arbtech TPP 01 Rev a Tree Protection Plan, shall be erected prior to commencement of development, shall remain unaltered and in situ, unless otherwise specified, for the entire duration of the construction.

No alterations or variations to the approved works or tree protection schemes shall be made without prior written consent of the local planning authority.

REASON: To ensure existing trees, shrubs and hedges that are identified as being retained are not removed and are protected appropriately during the development, as they are considered essential to enhance the character of the development and contribute positively to the appearance of the area.

04 COMPLIANCE: IMPLEMENTATION OF LANDSCAPING SCHEME

CONDITION: All changes in ground levels and soft/hard landscaping shown on the approved landscaping details:

- o 1132-MP-01 Landscape Masterplan
- o 1132-ST-01 Landscape Proposals Information

shall be carried out in full during the first planting and seeding season (October - March inclusive) following the commencement of the development, or in such other phased arrangement as may be approved, in writing, by the local planning authority up to the first use/first occupation of the development. Any trees, hedges, shrubs or turf identified within the approved landscaping details (both proposed planting and existing) which die, are removed, seriously damaged or seriously diseased, within a period of 10 years of being planted, or in the case of existing planting within a period of 5 years from the commencement of development, shall be replaced in the next planting season with others of similar size and same species unless otherwise agreed in writing by the local planning authority.

REASON: To ensure that the approved landscaping scheme is implemented in accordance with the approved scheme and has sufficient time to establish, in the interests of visual amenity and the quality of the development.

05 COMPLIANCE: NOISE ASSESSMENT METHODOLOGY & RECOMMENDATIONS

CONDITION: The development hereby approved shall be carried out in strict accordance with the methodology set out within the accompanying Noise Impact Assessment (NIA) Rev 00 (Scotch Partners, May 2024), and shall be constructed in accordance with the recommendations set out within Section 5.2 of the NIA, unless otherwise agreed in writing by the local planning authority.

REASON: To minimise external noise intrusion into bedrooms within the proposed extension and ensure a satisfactory development in terms of noise pollution.

06 FURTHER APPROVAL: CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT TO BE AGREED

CONDITION: Prior to the commencement of development details of the construction methodology and timetable shall be submitted to and approved, in writing, by the Local Planning Authority.

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This shall incorporate the following information: -

- a) Confirmation of the hours of operation on the site. No vehicle connected with the works to arrive on site before 07:30 or leave after 19:00 (except in the case of emergency). Working hours to be restricted between 08:00 and 18:00 Monday to Saturday (finishing at 13:00 on Saturday) with no working of any kind permitted on Sundays or any Public/Bank Holidays.
- b) Details of the loading/unloading/storage of construction materials on site, including details of their siting and maximum storage height.
- c) Details of how construction and worker traffic and parking shall be managed. This shall include routing of all traffic and any directional signs to be installed and where.
- d) Details of wheel and underbody washing facilities to be provided and used at the site.
- e) Details of any protection measures for footpaths and trees surrounding the site.
- f) Details of any means of access to the site during construction.
- g) Details of the scheduled timing/phasing of development for the overall construction period.
- h) Details of measures to control the emission of dust and dirt during construction and including details of any wheel washing to be undertaken, management and location it is intended to take place.
- i) Details of the siting of any on site compounds and portaloos.
- j) Details of the method of any demolition to take place, including the recycling and disposal of said materials resulting from demolition.
- k) Site waste management plan (that shall include reuse and recycling of materials) and the prohibition of the burning of materials on the site.
- l) Scheme for sustainable construction management to ensure effective water and energy use.
- m) A scheme to control noise and vibration during the construction phase, including details of any piling operations. If piling is to be carried out on the site a rationale for the piling method chosen and details of the techniques to be employed which minimise noise and vibration to nearby residents shall be provided.
- n) Scheme of review of complaints from neighbours.
- o) Registration and details of a Considerate Constructors Scheme.

The said methodology as may be approved shall be implemented in its entirety and shall operate as may be approved at all times during construction.

REASON: To minimise detriment to nearby residential and general amenity by controlling the construction process to achieve the approved development. This condition is required to be agreed prior to the commencement of any development as any construction process, including site preparation, by reason of the location and scale of development may result in adverse harm to neighbouring residents' amenities and the amenities of existing hotel users.

07 COMPLIANCE: PARKING PROVIDED PRIOR TO OCCUPATION

CONDITION: The extension hereby approved shall not be occupied until such time as the revised vehicle parking area, powered two-wheeler/cycle parking facilities indicated on the approved plans, including any parking spaces for the mobility impaired, has been hard surfaced, sealed and marked out in parking bays. The vehicle parking area and associated turning area shall be retained in this form at all times. The vehicle parking shall not be used for any purpose other than the parking of vehicles that are related to the use of the development unless otherwise agreed with the Local Planning Authority.

REASON: To ensure that on street parking of vehicles in the adjoining streets does not occur in the interests of highway safety and that appropriate parking is provided.

08 COMPLIANCE: TURNING AREA PROVIDED PRIOR TO OCCUPATION

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CONDITION: Prior to occupation of the extension hereby approved the revised vehicular turning facility, shall be provided and constructed in accordance with approved drawing no. 6133 - P-010 Rev. C, and maintained free from obstruction within the site at all times for that sole purpose.

REASON: To ensure that vehicles can enter and leave the highway in a forward gear in the interest of highway safety.

09 ACTION REQUIRED: IN THE EVENT OF UNEXPECTED GROUND CONDITIONS

CONDITION: The Local Planning Authority shall be contacted in the event of unexpected ground conditions being encountered during construction and the below minimum precautions shall be undertaken immediately.

Minimum requirements for dealing with unexpected ground conditions being encountered during construction.

1. All site works at the position of the suspected contamination will stop and the Local Planning Authority and Environmental Health Department will be notified as a matter of urgency.
2. A suitably trained geo-environmental engineer should assess the visual and olfactory observations of the ground and the extent of contamination and the Client and the Local Authority should be informed of the discovery.
3. The suspected contaminated material will be investigated and tested appropriately in accordance with assessed risks. The investigation works will be carried out in the presence of a suitably qualified geo-environmental engineer. The investigation works will involve the collection of solid samples for testing and, using visual and olfactory observations of the ground, delineate the area over which contaminated materials are present.
4. The unexpected, contaminated material will either be left in situ or be stockpiled (except if suspected to be asbestos) whilst testing is carried out and suitable assessments completed to determine whether the material can be re-used on site or requires disposal as appropriate.
5. The testing suite will be determined by the independent geo-environmental specialist based on visual and olfactory observations.
6. Test results will be compared against current assessment criteria suitable for the future use of the area of the site affected.
7. Where the material is left in situ awaiting results, it will either be reburied or covered with plastic sheeting.
8. Where the potentially contaminated material is to be temporarily stockpiled, it will be placed either on a prepared surface of clay, or on 2000-gauge Visqueen sheeting (or other impermeable surface) and covered to prevent dust and odour emissions.
9. Any areas where unexpected visual or olfactory ground contamination is identified will be surveyed and testing results incorporated into a Verification Report.
10. A photographic record will be made of relevant observations.
11. The results of the investigation and testing of any suspect unexpected contamination will be used to determine the relevant actions.
12. The scheme shall subsequently be implemented prior to occupation.

- o To ensure the effective operation of SuDS features over the lifetime of the development.

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- o To provide mitigation of any environmental harm which may be caused to the local water environment.

The proposal seeks retrospective planning permission for the existing 2m fence sited along the boundary of the site. The fencing itself is a mixture of green and grey metal boards with most of it being sited hard up to the boundary shared with the public pavement. The application also proposes a timber fence structure which will be bolted onto the existing metal fencing, on its roadside elevation, therefore appearing as a noticeable and highly prominent feature in Tendring Road.

Due to the proximity of the fencing to the highway boundary and its significant length it will be prominent in views along Heath Road and Tendring Road. Moreover, it is noted that in many areas there is no planting shown to the front of the fence as this will be unachievable due to its close relationship with the boundary.

Consequently, the siting of the fencing appears as a prominent and noticeable feature within Tendring Road and Heath Road and in the absence of little landscaping to soften its appearance appears as an intrusive feature harmful to the character and appearance of the site's countryside setting.

It is therefore considered that the proposed fencing, by virtue of its siting along a prominent boundary of the site results in an inappropriate form of development within the street scene, significantly detrimental to visual amenity and the overall character of the area, which is contrary to the aforementioned national and local policies.
