Notice is hereby given that the Tendring District Council, as District
Planning Authority, on 2 February 1977 made a Direction under Article 4 (3)(b)
of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1973 as amended, in
respect of land to the east of the junction of The Broadway and Badminton Road,
Jaywick, Clacton-on-Sea, Essex.

The Direction has now been approved and made permanent by the Secretary of
State for the Environment and notice of his decision is hereby given in accordance
with Article 4(5) of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1973.

The effect of the Direction is that, within the area to which it relates
permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to the
development specified in item 2 of Class IV of Schedule 1 to the Town and
Country Planning General Development Order 1973, that is to say:

The use of land (other than a building or the curtilage of a
building) for any purpose or purposes except as a caravan site
on not more than 28 days in total in any calendar year (of which
not more than 14 days in total may be devoted to use for the
purpose of motor car or motor cycle racing or for the purpose
of the holding of markets), and the erection or placing of
moveable structures on the land for the purposes of that use

A copy of the Direction and the map defining the area to which it relates
may be inspected during normal office hours in the office of the Secretary
and Legal Officer of the Tendring District Council, Council Offices, Weeley,
Clacton-on-Sea, Essex.

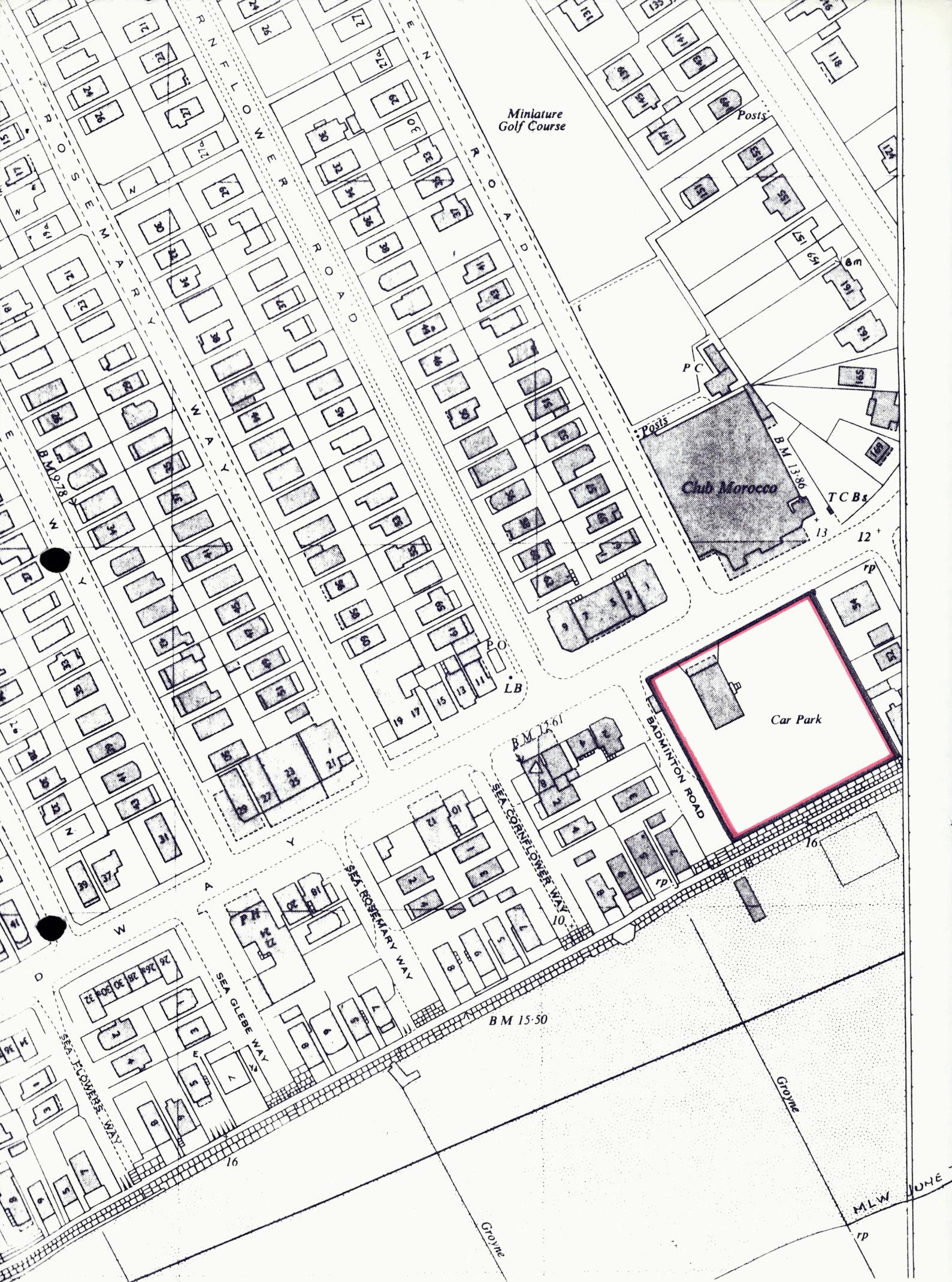
