

Revocation of the Essex Coast Recreational Disturbance Avoidance and Mitigation Strategy (RAMS) Supplementary Planning Document

In accordance with Regulation 15 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended) which remain in effect in accordance with the provisions of schedule 1 of the Levelling-up and Regeneration Act 2023 (Commencement No. 11 and Saving and Transitional Provisions) Regulations 2026, notice is hereby given that the following Supplementary Planning Document is revoked:

Essex Coast Recreational Disturbance Avoidance and Mitigation Strategy (RAMS) Supplementary Planning Document (2020)

The reason for revocation is that the content of the document is no longer fully aligned with the 2026 revised RAMS Strategy, evidence base and tariff. The recommendation to revoke the SPD was approved by Cabinet on 26 June 2026 and takes effect from 01 August 2026. Following the revocation of the above SPD, all physical and digital copies of the document will no longer be available, in line with Regulation 15.
